Many of our teachers have become very adept with the computer because you wanted to keep in touch with your students and enable them to use the time profitably. You have kept busy designing lessons using the computer, setting homework and marking these assignments. You have been 'zooming' with your students and progressing with your syllabus. I was absolutely delighted when a friend introduced me to zoom and taught me how to use it. I have used it to teach my Bible Knowledge class and we have really enjoyed meeting around the study of Acts of the Apostles.

This partial lockdown has taught me to live a day at a time. A friend sent me a video clip of what green pastures really mean in Psalm 23. It does not mean a rich green meadow in Israel. It means a brown dry hill slope facing westwards to catch the little bit of rainfall from the Mediterranean Sea and the west wind that brings a little bit of humidity to the area. That is sufficient for little tufts of grass to grow in between rocks. Each tuft is just enough for sheep to have a mouthful of grass as they pass them. A few steps later they find another tuft of grass. Thus they will have the right amount to keep them going for the next day. The shepherd knows where to take the sheep to give them what they need.
